We are an international and intergenerational network that aims to raise awareness of the fight against climate change.

## OBJECTIVES

## COMMITMENTS

**The GYCP is committed to** encouraging young people to take action and give their opinion, provide them with a participatory methodology (crowdsourcing, networks, workshops...), organise meetings with scientists and decision-makers (conferences, exhibitions, participation in COPs).

**The school is committed to** implementing and sustaining an action project to combat climate change involving local communities, working in pairs with a high school located in the same territory or on another continent, respecting the values of the GYCP.

## VALUES

- The need for a creative dialogue between generations, the voice of young people is considered as much as voices of adults;
- The awareness of belonging to a Planetary Citizenship, implying a transformation of human relations, a metamorphosis that makes possible a new destiny for Humanity;
- The imperative to break with the model that perpetuates economic, human and environmental misery and leads us to foreseeable disasters;
- The will to "resignify" the world: to redefine it, to give it meaning;
- Taking into account the complexity of the problems addressed and the urgency of developing our faculties of transformation;
- Openness to different points of view, seeking and finding new paths together, guided by solidarity and fraternity.
